SASOL COMMITMENT TO ADDRESSING ITS SULPHUR DIOXIDE BOILER EMISSIONS

We refer to the meeting we had with you on 1 October 2019 during which we discussed Sasol's responses to environmental sustainability, including our approach to air quality management. At this meeting, you also invited Sasol to participate in the Plastics Colloquium and further indicated that a follow up meeting should take place.

Regarding the Plastics Colloquium, Sasol participated fully and found it to be a very important and useful platform to share our efforts in dealing with the challenge of plastic waste in the environment and also to learn from others regarding their initiatives.

Sasol supports and continues to engage with the Panel of Experts on SO₂. We wish to reiterate that we remain committed to sustainable air quality improvement. We believe that the limit of 1 000 mg/m³n provided for in the pending draft regulations is representative of a reasonable standard which Sasol could achieve through significant effort. We would appreciate an opportunity, at your earliest convenience, to further engage with you on Sasol's position and efforts in this regard.
